Under 18s Environmental Photographic Competition

District 105BS is introducing an Environmental Photographic Competition for Young People under the age of eighteen at 14th. February 2011.

It is a photo contest that we hope provides a way for Young People to demonstrate, through an original photograph, their observation and commitment to improving, protecting or preserving the environment in which they live today.

Entrants will be required to accompany their photo with a brief description explaining why the environment being shown in the photo should be improved, protected or preserved.

The competition is divided into three categories, which are:

- Plant Life
- Animal Life
- Landscapes (Urban or Natural)

The winner of each category will receive £50, the runner up £25.

The District would like to acknowledge the support of the Laspen Trust who are sponsoring this year's competition.

Individual candidates may only enter one category to the District 105BS Contest. However, Clubs can submit entries from any number of candidates. This is hoped to encourage a greater interest and involvement by Lions Clubs of District 105BS.

Entries to be sent to DO Lion John Vaughan. 3. Upper Dingle, Madeley, Telford. TF7 5RX. Post marked on or before the closing date of 14th. February 2011.

It is hoped that the competition will extend into following years. The categories remaining the same to encourage continuity.

This year's final will be judged by 1st. March 2011 with the winner's announced at District Convention 2011.

COMPETITION RULES

1. The promoter of the competition is Lions District 105BS District Governor.
2. The entrant must have taken the photograph.
3. The copyright of the entire image must be held by the entrant, permissions for display and publication of the photograph by Lions Clubs, District and International are automatically granted by the entrant upon entry of the competition. The moral right of the copyright owner will be acknowledged.
4. The entrant shall provide 1 print not greater than 30cm x 21cm, also 1 self addressed envelope if the return of the photograph is required. All entries must be accompanied by an entry form correctly completed. Winners and runner ups of each category will be asked to provide an electronic image in addition.
5. District 105BS does not accept liability for any loss or damage.
6. All images should have been taken on or after 1st. July 2010 and shall not have won any other competition.
7. Judges will be appointed by the District Governor and their decision will be final.
8. Photographs should be marked with the entrants name on a sticker on the back.
9. All entrants must be under 18 years of age on 14th February 2011.

Lions from clubs in good standing are invited to enter an original, unaltered black and white or colour photo (without people) of the environment of their Lions Club area in the following categories in the 2009-10 Lions Environment Photo Contest

- Animal life
- Plant life
- Landscape (urban or natural)
- Weather phenomenon
- Special annual category (to be announced by Oakbrook)

Entries should be 8” x 10” (20.3cm x 25.4cm) prints and should each be accompanied by an official entry form.

This year to encourage more entries there is no need for a club level competition and all entries should be sent direct to DO John Vaughan, 3 Upper Dingle, Madeley, Telford TF7 5RX by 31st December 2010 for district level judging. However entrants are limited to one print per category.

The winning entries in each category will be sent on to the Multiple District level competition and winners from there for judging at the International Convention in Seattle June 2011. An award will be presented to the winning photographers. The six (the five category winners and the best of show) winning photos will appear on the Lions web site

It is hoped to display all district entries at our convention at The Whitehouse in March 2011.
